CALL FOR PAPERS

International Conference of Linguistics
(Skopje, October 20-21, 2020)

1. Title of the conference:

"MACEDONIAN LANGUAGE – A SOURCE OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH (AT HOME AND ABROAD)"

2. The Conference will be held on October 20-21, 2020.

3. The Conference will be held at the Institute of Macedonian Language "Krste Misirkov" – Skopje. Address: "Grigor Prlichev," no. 5, 1000 Skopje, North Macedonia

4. Purpose:

The choice of this year's Conference central topic was motivated by the current developments in the world. Social distancing during times of pandemic has called for a more frequent use of the adverbials *at home* and *abroad* (or *outside*): *Stay home!*, *Do not travel abroad!*, *Don't go outside without a good reason!* ... Therefore, *at home* : *abroad* (or *outside*) emerges as a very present dichotomy in modern living from many points of view, including the linguistic one. Bearing in mind a broader understanding of the aforementioned dichotomy, here are a few possible research fields:

- Macedonian language, culture, literature, history and folklore – *at home* (in our country) and *abroad*;
- Stylistic stratification – the language style used *at home* and *outside* of home or *abroad*;
- Teaching Macedonian *at home* (in our country) and *abroad*, i.e. Macedonian as mother tongue and Macedonian as a second/foreign language; challenges and benefits of online teaching and online research into Macedonian language; the current situation with the online resources related to Macedonian studies and the need for more serious efforts in this direction.

May this current dichotomy inspire you for the following suggested subtopics as well:

- The Slavic Manuscript Heritage
- Dialectological research
- Grammar research
- Lexicological research
- Stylistic research
- Sociolinguistic research

This Conference aims to achieve one of the basic principles of the Institute of Macedonian Language, which is the promotion of the Macedonian language as a member of the global language family.

8. The presentation of papers is limited to 10 minutes. Discussions will be held at the end of the sessions.

9. Abstracts and papers

Abstracts (not exceeding 250 words with up to 5 keywords) will be put on CD (with CIP-record prepared by the NUL "St. Kliment Ohridski" – Skopje), which will be included in the working materials.

The papers (up to 10 pages) presented at the Conference will be printed in a separate volume.

(See the enclosure for instructions). The papers will be peer reviewed. We encourage the participants to fully prepare and send the papers for review prior to the Conference or right after its closure.

10. Conference fee is 25 Euros, covering organizational costs, conference folder, refreshments during coffee breaks, as well as the costs of conference proceedings publication. The transport and accommodation costs are not covered by the organizers of the conference.

PUBLICATION INFORMATION AND STYLE-SHEET

The number of pages is limited to 10, written in Times New Roman, in A4 format, size 12 font, single-spaced.

First page

The name and surname of the author/authors, affiliation, city and country should be placed in the upper left corner. For example:

Temjana Jovanovska
Institute of Macedonian Language “Krstе Misirkov” – Skopje
Skopje, Macedonia

The title should be in a central position with capital letters, and the abstract should be placed under the title with bold letters, size 10 font. If the paper is written in one of the Slavic languages or in English, then the abstract should be written in Macedonian. For example:

TITLE

Abstract: Во оваа статија е направена анализа на особеностите на глаголите од семантичкото поле за визуелна перцепција во македонскиот јазик. Посебен акцент е ставен на синтаксичката шема на секој од овие глаголи со осврт на нијансите на значења што секој одделен глагол ги носи. Притоа се анализирани и одделните парови во однос на категоријата аспект во македонскиот јазик со поткрепа на нивната употреба во контексти собрани од електронски списанија.

Keywords: македонистика, синтакса, валенција на глаголот.

At the end of the paper, a summary should be placed (up to 250 words), written in one of the widely spoken languages, different from the language in which the paper is written.

Referencing

When quoting, paraphrasing or referring to an author / text, the source should be indicated in the text, not in the footnotes below. The author's surname and year of publication should be given in parenthesis, e.g. (Koneski 1999). When necessary, provide a more detailed reference with a page number, e.g. (Koneski 1999: 33).

List of references and sources

A list of references must be given at the end of the paper for each cited (or paraphrased) work. First, provide the works in Cyrillic, and then in Roman alphabet, according to the alphabetical order of the author's surname. If there are more than one work by the same author, they must be given in a chronological order. References should not be numbered. If the same author has both authored and coauthored work, the former should be listed first.

Each bibliographic unit should include: the surname and the name of the author (s), year of publication, and the title of the paper. For journal articles, it is obligatory to give the name of the journal, the year of publication, the number of the journal, and page numbers. All references should provide the name of the publisher and the place of publication. The titles of the books and journals should be in italics, while the titles of the papers published in journals or edited volumes should be put in quotation marks. Dictionaries or other types of books written by several authors should be listed by the title and the number of the volume.
